

The Dialogue of Civilizations and Cross-Cultural Cooperation is a cycle of annual seminars aiming to analyze the regulatory framework and international practice for the development of international and multicultural education; exchange of innovative experience and practices among Moscow, Russian regions and foreign countries in providing equal access to educational services in preschool, school and additional education as well as life long education. The Project plays the role of **an international laboratory** by rendering academic and methodological support to a network of international educational centres and programmes. Over 800 people from 44 countries and 25 Russian regions have taken part in the seminar since its launch in 2009.
